1 Product Specification

1.1 Scope

The Primary Insiders product provides information concerning the following companies:

- Companies whose shares are quoted on Oslo Børs
- Savings Banks whose equity certificates are quoted on Oslo Børs

The quoted companies are obliged to keep Oslo Børs informed of their primary insiders and the Primary Insiders product contains up to date information.

1.2 Record Definition

1.2.1 Data types

These are the definitions of the data types used in the record layout:

Data type	Description
Date	Encoded as MM/DD/YYYY HH:MM:SS
Integer	Integer with maximum value 2 ³¹
Char(n)	Trimmed string of printable characters (ISO8859-1) with maximum length n

1.2.2 Record layout

Field Name	Data Type	Description
Serial number	Integer	Serial number
Symbol	char(12)	Local code, often referred to as ticker symbol
Security Name	char(34)	Full name of security
ISIN	char(12)	ISIN number
First Name	char(34)	First name of primary insider
Last Name	char(34)	Family name of primary insider
Title	char(30)	The primary insiders title
Commission	char(30)	The primary insiders commission
From Date	Date	The date from when the person became primary insider in the particular company.

1.2.3 Sort criteria

The list is sorted alphabetically by symbol.

1.3 Distribution methods

Primary Insiders is delivered by means of e-mail or ftp (get).

The files will be distributed by e-mail or uploaded to the customers ftp area every trading day at 20.00 (CET).

To ensure reliability of the data material, the date of the actual data upload will be specified in the file name, insiders_YYYYMMDD.txt.

For providing the information through email Oslo Børs require only one email-address for the recipient of the information. Oslo Børs produces the information and sends it to the pre-defined address.

For use of FTP Oslo Børs produces the information and stores it in a file on a dedicated customer directory on our distribution server. The customer is responsible for retrieving the files(s). The directory on the distribution server is provided by Oslo Børs when registration for a product is done.

1.4 File format

The files produced for both email and ftp are flat text files. The fields in the file are separated by [;]. Null observations are indicated by empty fields, i.e. [;][;].
